German Vocabulary Expansion: the ent- Prefix

The ent- prefix on German verbs can have three fundamentally different functions. It can 1. be the opposite of another action (e.g. entladen); 2. express that something is being removed (e.g. enteisen); or 3. intensify/expand an action (e.g. entleeren).

The following verbs use the ent- prefix to intensify or expand the basic action of the verb. Example: leeren (to empty) → entleeren (to empty out). In these verbs, the ent- prefix loosely corresponds to "out", but the meaning of the verb with or without the prefix is often quite similar.

German verb	Basic Action	English equivalent
entflammen	flammen	to break into flames, to kindle (fig. or lit.)
entfliehen	fliehen	to escape, get away from
entgehen	gehen	to escape, avoid (fig. or lit.)
entlassen	lassen	to let go (fire)
entleeren	leeren	to empty out, drain
entlohn	lohn	to reward
entlüften	lüften	to air out, ventilate
entnehmen	nehmen	to extract, take out of (fig. or lit.)
entnerven	nerven	to unnerve, get on someone's nerves
entsenden	senden	to send out
entzünden	zünden	to light a fire (fig. or lit.)
